GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration

- Registration is possible on Friday (8:00–12:30) and Saturday (8:30–11:00) in the Cultural Centre Postojna (Gregorčičev drevored 2a, Postojna).
- **Registration is obligatory for all participants.**

Oral presentations

- Lectures will take place in the Cultural Centre Postojna (Gregorčičev drevored 2a, Postojna).
- **PowerPoint presentations should be given to the organizers during the break before the Session with the presentation.**
- **Maximum duration of the lecture is 15 min** (12 min for talk and 3 min for discussion). **Invited lecturers (keynote speakers) have 20 min for the lecture.** Due to a tight schedule, we ask you to please be punctual.

Posters

- **Poster size: mandatory max. format is A0 – 841 x 1189 mm (portrait layout).**
- Poster display will be held at the Cultural Centre Postojna (Gregorčičev drevored 2a, Postojna).
- Leave the posters at the registration desk on Friday, September 11th, between 8:00 and 9:00.
- Stand by your poster during the poster display.

Meals

- Lunches are not organized during the session days.
- Simple lunches will be provided during excursions on Thursday and Sunday, but we recommend bringing some additional snacks.
- Lunch breaks are included into the program on Friday and Saturday. Several restaurants are available, including Štorja pod stopnicami, Bar Bor, Pri kaminu, Čuk, Pizzaria Minutka, Okusi Filiponov (see the map below).

Excursions

- **Participation in the excursion is possible only if you registered for it during registration.**
- All excursions will be combined with a bus drive and walk (few km per day).
- Bus departure for the excursions is from the Postojna bus station (marked as No. 3 on the map of Postojna).
- Because of visits of caves, walking shoes and field clothes are obligatory. At most excursions, a moderate walking is expected. Please, be ready for possible rain.
- Insect repellent is recommended, as we will be walking in areas where ticks (*Ixodes ricinus*) are common. They can transmit Lyme disease and tick-borne encephalitis. Please check yourself carefully each evening after the excursion.
- Participation in the excursions is voluntary and at participants own risk. The organizers accept no liability for any loss, damage, injury or death arising from or in connection with the excursions. Participants are advised to obtain appropriate insurance coverage and must comply with the organiser's instructions.

Official ceremony

- The ceremony on September 12th will take place in Postojna Cave, so please dress warmly and wear suitable footwear.
- Attendance is limited to participants who registered for the ceremony when completing their conference registration and invited guests.
- As the cave train departs at **18:00**, please **arrive at the meeting point in front of Postojna Cave by 17:15**. No later train will be provided.
- Before the train departs, the official group photo will be taken.

Organised transport with Toyota GO

- After downloading the application, please create a user account and select the Postojna unit.
- Available transport options will be published in the application. Participants are asked to reserve their preferred transport slot in advance.
- **We kindly recommend that reservations are made one day before the planned transport or, at the latest, sufficiently in advance on the day of travel,** so that the organisers can plan the available vehicles and routes accordingly.
- **Please note that passengers with confirmed reservations will have priority.** Additional passengers without prior reservation may be accepted only if seats are still available.
